





YouTube Kids – Adding Approved Channels

- 1 Select YouTube Kids and press the Padlock in the bottom right corner




- 2 Enter your Parent Passcode













As an example, I have used the magnifying glass and type in Disney

I selected the Official Disney channel that came up in the search and pressed Got It






You will be taken back to the following screen where you can continue to use the top arrow to move back to the main screen
